The Project

Macmahon's contract at Lhoknga involves all limestone mining activities at the site. The plant is located about 17 kilometres from Banda Aceh, on the north west coast of Sumatra, an area that suffered serious devastation from the December 2004 tsunami.

Macmahon's scope of work at Lhoknga includes the drill, blast and mining of limestone to supply the region's largest cement manufacturing plant. The contract also involves Macmahon undertaking the construction of haul roads for use by mining trucks.
